Attached for Council approval are a resolution and contract to purchase a replacement 5/7yd dump truck with snowplow and spreader. Public Works staff utilize these trucks for snow removal, road repairs and material hauling needs. This unit will replace a 2017 unit that has met its life expectancy. The unit has been plagued with costly repairs and breakdowns.
