

ADOPT - A- PARK AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into on this ____ day of _____, 2026 by and between the MUNICIPALITY OF PRINCETON, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, 400 Witherspoon Street, Princeton, New Jersey, 08540 (hereinafter referred to as “PRINCETON”) and the FRIENDS OF HERRONTOWN WOODS (hereinafter referred to as “FOHW”), PO Box 1325, Princeton, NJ 08542 United States.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, PRINCETON is responsible for the management and maintenance of the parkland known as Autumn Hill Reservation; and

WHEREAS, FOHW is a non-profit corporation of the State of New Jersey that since 2013 has maintained and improved various trails in the Autumn Hill Reservation to reduce chronic problems with mud and invasive species, and to show off historic features; and

WHEREAS, FOHW received an award for its stewardship of Autumn Hill Reservation in 2013; and

WHEREAS, FOHW have volunteered to “adopt” the parkland known as Autumn Hill Reservation as permitted by the “Adopt-a-Park Law”, N.J.S.A., 40:12-20, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, PRINCETON appreciates groups and organizations who volunteer their time and efforts to improve and maintain the parklands located within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, PRINCETON and FOHW wish to enter into this Agreement to reflect their mutual understandings with regard to having FOHW “adopt” Autumn Hill Reservation; and

WHEREAS, FOHW have demonstrated to PRINCETON that they are amply capable of maintaining, operating and improving Autumn Hill Reservation according to the terms of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the execution of this Agreement has been duly authorized by formal action of the Princeton Mayor & Council and the Board of Trustees of the Friends of Herrontown Woods, as evidenced by the resolutions or meeting minutes attached hereto as Exhibits C and D;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein and other good and valuable considerations, PRINCETON and FOHW agree as follows:

1. PRINCETON agrees to have FOHW “adopt” Autumn Hill Reservation.
2. FOHW and PRINCETON agree to follow all the guidelines and assume all responsibilities laid out in the Autumn Hill Reservation Management and Use Agreement (“MUA”), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof. The MUA may from time to time be revised by mutual approval of FOHW and PRINCETON’s Department of Recreation and Department of Infrastructure and Operations.
3. The term of this Agreement shall be for ten years, and may be renewed thereafter on the same terms or such other terms as may be mutually agreeable between PRINCETON and FOHW. PRINCETON may terminate this Agreement at any time without prior notice to FOHW for any reason, including, but not limited to, failure of FOHW to comply with any terms or conditions of this Agreement. FOHW may terminate this Agreement upon at least six months’ written notice to PRINCETON.
4. In accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40:12-26b(1), FOHW and each employee, agent, contractor, member or volunteer of FOHW assisting in the maintenance, operation or improvement of Autumn Hill Reservation pursuant to this Agreement shall sign a waiver releasing PRINCETON, its agents, servants and employees from and against any civil liability for any injury or damages (except those arising from criminal, willful, wanton or grossly negligent conduct) that may be sustained by FOHW, or any employee, agent, contractor, member

or volunteer thereof, during the course, or as a result of, any activities whatsoever conducted at Autumn Hill Reservation pursuant to the terms of this Agreement. Said waiver shall be in the form attached hereto as Exhibit B or such other form as shall have been reviewed and approved by PRINCETON's Municipal Attorney, and may be submitted on an annual basis.

5. In accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40:12-26b(3), FOHW shall obtain and retain general liability insurance in an amount sufficient for the purposes set forth in paragraph 4 above. FOHW shall provide a certificate of liability insurance to PRINCETON evidencing such coverage and naming PRINCETON, including its employees and agents, as an additional insured.

6. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:12-27, FOHW, their employees, agents, and volunteer assistants shall not be considered to be "public employees" or "state employees" for the purposes of the New Jersey Tort Claims Act, N.J.S.A. 59:1-1 *et seq.*, or otherwise be accorded any of the protections set forth therein, while performing any improvements, projects, maintenance, clean-up or repair activities at Autumn Hill Reservation pursuant to this Agreement.

7. FOHW shall comply with PRINCETON's rules and regulations for parks and recreation areas (currently codified in Chapter T16 of Princeton's Code) and with the rules and regulations promulgated by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program (N.J.A.C. 7:36-1 *et seq.*).

8. FOHW shall not enter into any third-party use or access agreements for Autumn Hill Reservation without PRINCETON's prior written consent.

9. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
